Par 5's – CAPTAIN'S CHOICE. Each golfer hits their own drive. Captain chooses best drive and all golfers hit from that shot. Captain chooses best 2nd shot and all golfers hit from there; same for all subsequent shots. Captain chooses best shot and all hit from that spot. Only one (1) score is recorded.

ABOUT THE GREATER BEL AIR COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

The Greater Bel Air Community Foundation was founded in April of 1998 by local citizens and business people concerned about the welfare of the families and citizens of Bel Air, the community, its facilities, and the Town. The Foundation has focused on support of capital projects to improve public and nonprofit facilities in Bel Air and the surrounding community.

The initial project of the Foundation was the construction of bleachers at Bel Air High School, raising almost \$300,000 of the \$400,000 cost. Additional major donations included \$50,000 towards the expansion of the William A. Humbert Amphitheatre at Shamrock Park, \$30,000 towards the restroom facility at Lyn Stacie Getz Creative Playground at Route 24 and Ring Factory Road.

In 2005, the Foundation created a playground grant program for area schools, awarding \$5,000 grants to Ring Factory Elementary School (2) and Wakefield Elementary School. In addition to the school playgrounds, the Foundation donated \$5,000 towards Annie's Playground at Edgeley Grove Farm and \$5,000 to the replacement of playground equipment at Homestead Park.

Numerous projects have been supported in recent years:

- \$25,000 Women's locker room at the Bel Air Armory;
- \$20,000 Headquarters of the Sexual Abuse Resource Center in memory of Foundation member Thomas Broumel;
- \$10,000 Climbing wall at Edgeley Grove Farm;
- \$25,000 Parks and Recreation woodshop and public restrooms at Heavenly Waters Park
- \$25,000 ARC Project (Phase1), an accessible home for persons with developmental disabilities
- \$25,000 Tucker Field
