Par 4’s – FLORIDA SCRAMBLE. Each golfer hits their drive. Captain chooses best drive. All golfers hit their next shot from that position and continue to play their own ball into hole. Two (2) best scores are recorded.

Par 5’s – CAPTAIN’S CHOICE. Each golfer hits their own drive. Captain chooses best drive and all golfers hit from that shot. Captain chooses best 2nd shot and all golfers hit from there; same for all subsequent shots. Captain chooses best shot and all hit from that spot. Only one (1) score is recorded.

ABOUT THE GREATER BEL AIR COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

The Greater Bel Air Community Foundation was founded in April of 1998 by local citizens and business people concerned about the welfare of the families and citizens of Bel Air, the community, its facilities, and the Town. The Foundation has focused on support of capital projects to improve public and nonprofit facilities in Bel Air and the surrounding community.

The initial project of the Foundation was the construction of bleachers at Bel Air High School, raising almost \$300,000 of the \$400,000 cost. In 2005, the Foundation created a playground grant program for area schools, awarding \$5,000 grants to Bel Air, Ring Factory, Wakefield Elementary Schools and Homestead Park, and Annie's Playground at Edgeley Grove Farm.
