### CAPTAIN'S CHOICE SCRAMBLE FORMAT

TEES – OVER 60 HIT FROM SENIOR TEE  
 ALL OTHERS HIT FROM BLUE TEE

EVERYONE TEES OFF AND THE TEAM CAPTAIN PICKS THE BEST DRIVE. THEN EVERYONE HITS THEIR NEXT SHOT FROM THAT SPOT. Continue with same format until your foursome finishes the hole. Record 1 score for each hole. You must use each player's Drive at least 2 times.

Individual Mulligans - Proper use of Individual MULLIGANS: THE PLAYER MAY USE 1 MULLIGAN (do over) on front nine and 1 Mulligan on back nine. No carry-overs to second nine. Cannot use Mulligans for putts on the green. See Team Mulligans below.

Team Mulligans - Proper use of TEAM MULLIGANS: Same as individual mulligans plus each player may choose one hole (not 1 on front and 1 on back) to take a putt mulligan (do over putt).
